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Notes from our Director



Since I became a faculty member at Boğaziçi University, I have found myself in an intense effort to foster, support, and grow entrepreneurship on campus. Boğaziçi University holds a very special place as an educational institution preferred by more than 700 of the top 1000 students who get the highest score in Turkey's university entrance exams. The majority of its graduates are highly influential people who have accomplished many successes both in Turkey and in the rest of the world. In fact, the most important feature that makes Boğaziçi University privileged and valuable is this network.

I believe that the reason for this is the strong roots of Boğaziçi's foundation, campus, and philosophy. As a matter of fact, creative self-confidence, which is at the core of entrepreneurship, can only grow in a climate that accommodates differences and ensures freedom of expression.

When we established the Entrepreneurship Center, we aimed to systematically improve the entrepreneurial successes at Boğaziçi based on the entrepreneurial genetics and essence of the university. For this reason, we define entrepreneurship as a mindset, a mentality, and a way of looking at life beyond establishing a company. In this way, we set out to show how anyone can be an entrepreneur, no matter where they are and what they are doing. So much so that, according to our definition, entrepreneurship means to be disturbed by something, to worry about something, to imagine better or even the unthinkable of what is offered, and to act with curiosity and quest to bring them to life. In fact, everyone has such stories in their life, big or small. The important thing is to realize this and to be involved in life actively rather than passively. The aim is building a life instead of living and going away.

To achieve this, it is recommended to get out of the comfort zone. There is one more thing I would like to add to this: While leaving your comfort, it is necessary to protect your peace. Hence, I define entrepreneurship as "peaceful discomfort." In peace, there is gratitude for what you have, enjoying what you do, and being excited about new trials, even if they end in frustration and disappointment. Because in the entrepreneurial mindset, the road to success goes through many failures.

We have adopted four main principles as our philosophy to explain this mindset. These principles consist of challenging the status quo, embracing failure, having a long-term view, and being selfless. We remind each other of these principles each time and determine what we do at the Bright Center accordingly. We invite everyone who wants to be an entrepreneur to implement these principles in their lives.

We have done a lot of work since the establishment of the center, but I personally think that the work we are most proud of is the Fire Up Changemakers Certificate and Fellowship Program. With the program, which we started thanks to our cooperation with Stanford University, and to which we involved ITU and METU's Entrepreneurship Centers, students contribute to the innovation climate on campus.

Our purpose for preparing this impact report is to promote Boğaziçi University Bright Center for Entrepreneurship both on and off campus and share with you a part of our work that we consider important if not all. I hope you will be as excited as we are on the following pages and will contact us for the next steps in your entrepreneurial journey.



With the 1512 Techno-Entrepreneurship Funding Support Program by TÜBİTAK, the activities from the idea stage to the market are supported so that entrepreneurs can transform their technology and innovation-oriented business ideas into startups with high added value and qualified employment creation potential. Technology and innovation-oriented, scalable projects or initiatives that are deemed appropriate by the startups applying through the application form gain the right to use the incubation center. Thus, in addition to encouraging qualified entrepreneurship, it is aimed to create start-up companies that have high international competitive power, and can develop innovative, high-tech products and services.

For Students

FireUp Change Makers Program



Fire-Up, which focuses on improving the entrepreneurship and social innovation skills of university students by adopting the concept of 'entrepreneurship as a mindset, was launched in 2020 with the partnership of Boğaziçi University Bright Center for Entrepreneurship and İTÜ GİNOVA Entrepreneurship and Innovation Center. 19 students from Boğaziçi University completed the program in which 500 applications were received, and 100 students participated. In the program, students were enabled to develop projects that would create change in the campus in line with their sustainable development goals. Stanford University 2017 UIF Fellow Zeynep Çelik contributed invaluable contributions to the program content, and 2019 UIF Fellow Fatih Gözükara was extremely instrumental and helpful in the functioning and communication of the program, and he played a key role in achieving success in the first year of the program.

In the program organized every year, students selected by the jury, including Boğaziçi University Bright Center for Entrepreneurship Center Director Assistant Professor Oğuzhan Aygören and İTÜ Assistant Professor Zeynep Beyazıt, provide an eight-week intensive, hands-on entrepreneurship and innovation training. Teams of students are expected to develop and implement projects to improve campus life throughout the process. During the program, with the active support of mentors from different fields of expertise, it is aimed to both keep the learning processes of the students alive and contribute to the success of the projects. At the end of the eight-week period, four students from ITU and four from Boğaziçi University are selected as a result of the interviews organized by a jury that includes important people from the entrepreneurship ecosystem and are eligible to be nominated for the 'University Innovation Fellowship' program organized by Stanford University d.school. In the continuation of the process carried out in partnership with Stanford University, students are accepted to the program after passing the interviews organized by Stanford University.

In the coming years, it is planned to expand the program's scope throughout Turkey and improve the educational content with the support. For this purpose, METU Entrepreneurship Center has been included in the program that started in 2022. Thus, the students of the three leading state universities of Turkey will have the opportunity to work together to produce a joint project with the Fireup program, and they will be included in the international network together with the Stanford University UIF program. In addition, Fire-Up is a workshop area where Bright can try new training methods, new creative approaches, and new teamwork types to be added to the knowledge pool. Every year, it creates the effect it wants to create on itself with the volunteer work of the previous year's graduates and its changing and developing system.

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University Innovation Fellowship Program with Stanford d.school



Boğaziçi University Bright Center for Entrepreneurship collaborates with the University Innovation Fellows (UIF) program by Stanford University and the Hasso Plattner Institute of Design (d.school).

Every year, four students selected from Boğaziçi University receive six-week training courses on business model development, design thinking, creativity, and innovation within the scope of UIF. Students who will be included in this program are selected from among students who have successfully completed the Fire Up program. In addition, four students selected to apply for the program and others evaluated in these elections are entitled to the title of "Bright Fellow" and have the opportunity to take initiative and carry out projects within Bright.

Zorlu Holding sponsored the program, which we first participated in in 2017 with the initiatives of Imece in 2017 and 2020. After 2018, when we could not send students due to financial difficulties, our students could continue to benefit from the program in 2019 with the financial contributions of Turkey's leading entrepreneurs and investors without expecting anything in return. Selected students not only receive education within the scope of the UIF program but also conduct research on entrepreneurship-related problems in their universities and develop projects to solve the identified problems.

Stanford University - UIF Silicon Valley Meetup 2022

The Silicon Valley Meetup, the first face-to-face meeting of the University Innovation Fellow program, organized by Stanford University d.school after the pandemic, was held on the Stanford University campus in March 2022. In addition to the participation of Boğaziçi University fellows Haluk Ziya Tercan, Zişan Özdemir and Arda Ulutürk, Asst. Prof. Oğuzhan Aygören and Assoc. Prof. Burcu Rodopman also physically attended the meeting.

Fellow students and faculty members from more than ten countries and different universities attended the three-day training, panels, and experience areas at the meetup. In the meetup, where the main purpose was to teach "leading change", opportunities were created to get to know technologies in different sectors, examine the Stanford University campus, develop leadership skills, empathize and work together. In addition to being inspired by the Stanford University ecosystem, our students had the opportunity to tour the Silicon Valley environment and make company visits.

Working with Bright for years, our students Haluk Ziya Tercan, Zişan Özdemir, and Arda Ulutürk, who are important examples of Bright's philosophy, did not see the problems they faced as unsolvable and managed to finance the visit to Silicon Valley meetup with methods such as crowdfunding and direct access to individuals living in the region.

"The Silicon Valley meetup was one of the turning points for me. As a result of the training we received, I experienced the excitement of being able to lead the change. In addition, I gained self-confidence with the inspiration of seeing Silicon Valley, San Francisco, and most importantly, Stanford University. Although I made a lot of benefits, the most important thing was that I realized that we are doing good work in Turkey and that we are not behind anyone. Although our opportunities are less than in other countries, we are highly motivated and work well. We have no reason to distrust ourselves. Like an entrepreneur, we will try harder to make the best use of our opportunities, and we will inspire others to do so."

There are many different ways to exist. Each person chooses one of these ways, or builds a new one for himself, depending on where he looks at the world. Sometimes a few people come together to create a collective consciousness of existence by being inspired by the past, the present, and the future, but mostly by each other. It is now their own new way of being, perhaps a small tribe.

This is how Bright set out. The concepts at hand when we set out were entrepreneurship, innovation, change, and discovery. We saw these concepts as a tool to answer our most fundamental question. Our most fundamental question is: "How to exist?". Each question is an equation in itself, it has its own constants and variables. We saw that the constant of this great, ancient and important question of humanity - how we will exist - was "change," and the variable was "human." For this reason, Bright built its journey to accept change as a constant and invest in people.

I think that one of the most basic instincts of human being, the search for the better, and the development as a result of this, are among the most sacred concepts of humanity. I believe that this is what separates the past from the present and what will make the future different from today. In the journey of man to the better, man should be freed and encouraged; should be given the opportunity to explore, see and try. Bright is exactly such a place.

A tribe, a playground where change leaders can exist in their own way, who believe in change and the destructive power of change, who base their existence on the ability of water to direct the flow of water and change things wherever they are, constantly discovering, learning, producing, and fighting for it when appropriate.

In this way, you can both take part in projects carried out by fellows in other countries and apply the practices you learned from them in your own projects. Moreover, the program has no end. My focus in the program was to develop a culture of social innovation in Boğaziçi. To this end, we aim to create a community called BUMPACT, to spread awareness of social impact, and to bring together everyone who has set their heart on this field in Boğaziçi.

BRIGHT allows 4 students to attend the UIF program organized by Stanford University every year. In my opinion, the most important feature of the UIF program is that the community comprises participants from all over the world. You can constantly find the opportunity to communicate with people from different countries, schools, and departments. For example, we met with a fellow from the Netherlands during our interview to participate in the program, and our mentor who accompanied us throughout the training was from the UAE. UIF's motto is "Students can change the world." and in accordance with this motto, it provides the necessary equipment and self-confidence to the students. After training, UIF expects you to work directly on a project to solve a school problem and contribute directly to the school's development. During these projects, you can come across many different things and learn a lot.

Startup Carnival

Since 2016, it has been an interactive entrepreneurship festival based on fun and learning every year. It is aimed that entrepreneurs in the ecosystem get to know and interact with each other.

More than 5000 people have participated in this festival, which has been held four times so far, cooperation between startups has been encouraged, job and internship opportunities have been offered to the participants, and many initiatives have been indirectly invested in thanks to the interactions established.

However, the Peter G. Peterson Foundation, the IBM Call for Code program, and Verizon company also offer many additional opportunities to students working in certain fields.




Pitching Day

LeanLAB

Academic coordination of LeanLab program, supported by the Istanbul Development Agency and the Ministry of Industry and Technology of the Republic of Turkey, was carried out by Oğuzhan Aygören, the director of Bright at Bogazici University, with the leading partnership of Özyeğin University.

The program is aimed at academicians and doctoral students who have business ideas with commercialization potential; aims to strengthen academic entrepreneurship based on university, public, and industry cooperation. A minimum of six and a maximum of ten academicians or doctoral students are accepted to the program each year.

Within the scope of this program, created in cooperation with Özyeğin University, training, mentoring support and consultancy services are provided to academicians and doctoral students who want to realize their academic business idea, from I-Corps and Business Model Generation certified trainers. In addition, infrastructure facilities and investor access are provided. This program offers six weeks of intensive training. The training, which were held for the first time in 2018, were hosted by Boğaziçi University in 2019.

Coronathon Turkey


With the onset of the Covid-19 epidemic on March 21-23, 2020, one of the first Hackathons to be held online in the world was organized. Coronathon Turkey was led by Asst. Prof. Oğuzhan Aygören, the director of Boğaziçi University Bright Center for Entrepreneurship, with the spark of a tweet and immediate call-to-action. As a result, an initiative was launched. More than 1500 applications were received to produce innovative solutions to the pandemic. At the end of the 48-hour online event, 150 new project ideas came up. These ideas were listed with the partnership of more than 50 leading institutions in their fields, and a total of 130,000 TL was awarded to the first 12 ideas with the support of the private sector. Afterward, special support of 600,000 TL was provided by Tübitak for the projects in the top 60 in Coronathon Turkey.

A total of more than 1000 hours of mentoring was carried out with 120 mentors. Assisted projects and established collaborations with the private sector. Some projects still work through TÜBİTAK BIGG program partners with an important opportunity provided for them to implement their ideas. Coronathon Turkey initiative received an invitation from the European Commission to carry out the 'EUvsVirus' hackathon, and this time, support was given to the realization of this hackathon across Europe with the participation of fifteen thousand people.

The organization's partners are Bright Center for Entrepreneurship, ITU Ginova, METU Gimer, Boğaziçi University Technology Transfer Office, Starting Point, Endeavor, Entrepreneurship Foundation, Habitat, Hello Tomorrow Turkey, KTH Event Agency, Migport, Talentmelon, Timur Sırt, Turkish Informatics Foundation, VIVEKA, TOBB, ISO, ITO, ATO and many other organizations and individual contributers.



- Coronathon Turkey brings together those who seek solutions to the problems created by COVID-19 and those who develop solutions and provides the necessary ground for the realization of innovative ideas.
- Coronathon Turkey supports all other institutions and organizations working on COVID-19.
- Coronathon Turkey is a multi-partner, flexible civil initiative. It consists of universities, NGOs, entrepreneurs, public institutions, the private sector, and independent persons.
- It is a project where concepts such as transparency, inclusiveness, consensus, cooperation, speed, and decentralization are at the forefront.
- Coronothan Turkey implements the following concrete steps to achieve the objectives:
 - It creates awareness of the problems that COVID-19 has created and will create.
 - Organizes hackathons to address the problems caused by COVID-19.
 - It supports the teaming of the participants.
 - Develops ideas through webinars and mentoring.
 - It supports the matching of ideas and teams with different institutions and organizations.
 - It directs the ideas that stand out in the hackathon to accelerator programs.

In July 2019, entrepreneurial high school students were hosted at Boğaziçi University at the Entrepreneurship and Technology Summer Camp organized by Boğaziçi University Bright Center for Entrepreneurship in partnership with Lifelong Learning Center (BÜYEM) and Innocampus.

World Care Academy -DIBA

World Care Academy works to help university students from all over the country who want to take good care of their world, and connect and create positive change. The Academy, which was prepared in cooperation with Kale Group, Boğaziçi University Lifelong Education Center (BÜYEM), Boğaziçi University Entrepreneurship Center, and the Boğaziçi University Graduate Business People Association (BRM), makes a difference with its rich content programs on management, leadership, and social entrepreneurship. It offers a learning experience. BUCREA - Boğaziçi University Creativity Lab

BUCREA - Boğazi Boğaziçi University Creativity Lab (BUCREA) is one of Bright's sub-student societies and the first. It was created by Haluk Ziya Tercan, a graduate of the Fire-Up Program and Fellow of the Stanford University UIF Program, as a result of Bright's desire to host communities to be established through initiatives in different verticals. Bright strives to support these communities, meet their essential needs, and ensure their development.

BUCREA focuses on creativity, innovation, and the desire to create change that traditional student communities lack. It has adopted different approaches from traditional communities. Its approach is structured in three phases:

- 1. Fields of Experience: With fields of experience, students gain knowledge by trying new technologies, approaches, methods, and tools. They interact directly with what they have learned.
- 2. Creativity: As a result of the new information learned, the potential connections that can be established in the mind are increased, and creativity is developed.
- 3. Change: Problems encountered with developing creativity can be viewed from different perspectives. Bright provides support with project development, and change is initiated.

BUCREA also strives to create a participatory, initiative-based structure by eliminating the hierarchical board mechanism that organizes and controls events in traditional student societies. For this reason, the experience areas of BUCREA are not a team of a few people, but each community participant. Each participant designs and presents experience areas that can be applied quickly in an area they know well or in the area they want to improve themselves even if they don't.


Having revealed its philosophy in its first year, BUCREA attracted the attention of 200 students in two months and enabled them to participate in communication channels. In the 12 experience areas organized, it achieved an average of 20 participants. The feedback from BUCREA will renew itself and will strive to strengthen the creativity muscles.





Mobile Gaming

We started the Mobile Gaming vertical with the Gaming 101 event, co-founded by Umut Ismetoğlu, a student of the Department of Business Administration and co-founder of Zerosum Games. Planning continues to host events such as mobile gaming vertical, which we will support with gaming workshops and game jams in the future, as well as mobile game academy and flutter training.




Microentrepreneurship

In this vertical, we aim to provide experience and promote the ecosystem by encouraging university students to use low-code and no-code tools. In these micro-enterprise projects, we take care to use artificial intelligence software such as GPT-3 and introduce the use of artificial intelligence in entrepreneurship to students. In our first micro-entrepreneurship project, Entrepreneurship Words Taboo, a web taboo game was designed by taking the words frequently used in the entrepreneurship ecosystem and creating forbidden words like in the taboo game with the help of GPT-3.

Blockchain, which started its journey as a trust protocol, is on its way to becoming an approach, a mindset, and a kind of new world philosophy with its contributions and promises to us. Followers of this philosophy are redefining many standards in the light of blockchain technology, and a whole new world is being built here.

As Bright, we are embarking on a journey to get to know and understand this brand new world better and to produce on this philosophy. We define ourselves on the ground of innovation, which is the intersection of the business-art-tech trio. We begin our journey by forming a learning and discovery group. We will learn, discover and produce together.



BUmpact

BUmpact is one of Bright's community verticals, united to be change leaders making an impact for a greener and more equal world. It aims to learn together in areas such as social entrepreneurship, sustainability, and the environment and to take action as a community where it can create transformation. Case studies, discussion sessions, events where social entrepreneurs come together, experience areas, resource, and communication network sharing, raising awareness by sharing activities, projects, and business opportunities in this field with the community are some of the areas BUmpact plans to work on.





Bright Entrepreneurship Newsletter

With the start of the 2021-2022 academic year at Boğaziçi University Entrepreneurship Center Bright, we have decided to convey the developments in the world of entrepreneurship to our subscribers with a weekly newsletter to increase participation at the Center and inform the participants. As of today, we have delivered 39 bulletins, in which we share weekly developments, to a total of 194 subscribers. In addition, we share the bulletins with the whole school every week through the corporate communication channel.



How can I bring my startup to BRIGHT?

There are three ways to do this: First, you can participate in the Pitching Day event organized by the volunteer students at the center with your idea. Afterwards, you can benefit from the feedback sessions and after the approval of the center director, you can bring your idea to life under the roof of Boğaziçi University Entrepreneurship Center.

Second, you can apply via the DREAMBU Incubation Center Application Form at http://girisim.boun.edu.tr/.

Finally, you can get the chance to be among us and benefit from the opportunities we provide through the DREAMBIGG program.

I have a project idea, but I haven't taken any steps to realize it yet, can I still implement my idea in BRIGHT?

YES. In order to apply to Boğaziçi Entrepreneurship Research and Application Center, you do not need to have taken your project/business idea to a certain stage or to have an MVP. You can contact us as long as you have motivation and ideas.

SSS (Sıkça Sorulan Sorular)

What are the opportunities that BRIGHT offers to me/us during the realization of my venture?

As a center, we provide you with mentoring support and help you create and implement your business idea. At the same time, we provide you with the necessary connections and accelerate your initiative. We do not directly invest in your venture, but if you are at the investment stage, we lead you to establish the necessary connections and introduce you to the investors.

What is required to join BRIGHT?

Nothing is required but your motivation and enthusiasm. Regardless of the class or department, we would be happy to see you among us if you are willing and you pass the interview after applying to us.

What are BRIGHT's future expectations and goals?

Our aim is to first bring the entrepreneurial mindset to everyone within Boğaziçi University, the university that trains the most entrepreneurs in Turkey, and then to the whole of Turkey, to raise individuals who create jobs, not job seekers, while at the same time creating and realizing the vision of "Boğaziçi 2030".
